Serving Our Communities

- Over **10,500 team members** used their paid volunteer leave to give back to our communities
- **75 leaders** across the credit union engaged in our local communities through volunteer service on **99 nonprofit organizations**
- **176 team members** served as **Community Service Champions**
- Team members created over **150 giving opportunities** since July 1, 2023
- **150 local schools** supported through our **School Partnerships Program**

Sustainability

- Through **Navy Federal's Greening Up Council**, staff was encouraged to use their own reusable cups for free coffee or pay a \$.25 fee for disposable cups. This initiative reduced disposable cup usage on campuses and earned **\$14,550**, which was donated to local environmental causes.
- **Over 550 team members** signed the **Recycling Pledge**, committing themselves to greener practices throughout the year.
